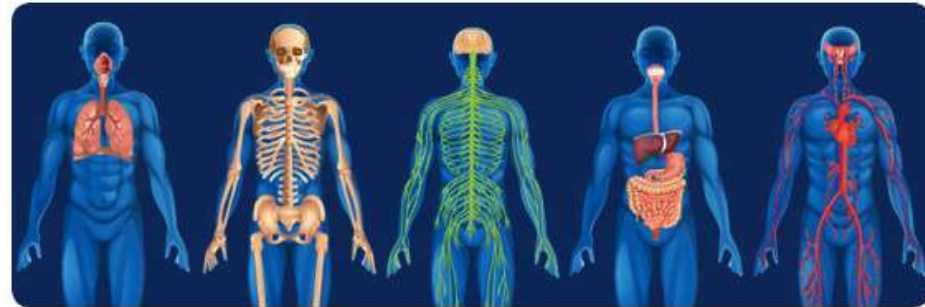

- Embase fait le lien avec le thésaurus de Medline, c'est-à-dire que si vous entrez le Mesh, la base de données vous dira qu'elle appellation a été retenue dans les Emtree pour ce terme. Ici, le Mesh "cell phone" devient l'Emtree "mobile phone".
